The sponsored shoot out and bouncy castle raised over £1000. The Friends of Brynteg School are looking at purchasing new equipment to improve the outdoor yard areas.

We have been awarded £1000 from the Tesco Bags of Help scheme. This means we are now able to redevelop the pond area later this term.

We received a grant from Wrexham's Play Sufficiency Team. This has enabled us to develop an new outdoor classroom which all of the classes will be able to use for a range of den building and forest schools type activities.

We have a tutor who will be in school from September 13th to provide weekly group guitar lessons,


These will be available to junior pupils for a cost of £3.75 a session/£37.50 for a ten week block.
