Nature Home Learning Menu - YEAR 2

Choose a task, complete it in your exercise book or on paper and stick it in. You can also take a photo and put it on seesaw.	
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Watch a nature programme and make notes on interesting facts you have learned.	
Draw your favourite animal and write what you know about it.	
Draw a flower. Can you tell me the names of the different parts?	
Stand by your door and close your eyes. Listen to the sounds. Draw or make a list of what you can hear.	
Draw the view from your bedroom window and draw the view you would love to have.	
Ask your adult to help you create a table with the headings land, water, both. How many animals can you name that live in these places?	
Create some wild art, using the natural things in your garden. Add a photo to SeeSaw	
There are lots of different cloud types. Take a photo of the sky and tell me what cloud you see.	
Keep a nature diary. Write down the time, the date and any animals you see.
